The students of the middle and senior wings of K.I.S. had the glorious opportunity of attending a workshop on India's second mission to the Moon, Chandrayaan 2. This workshop was conducted by the Society of Space Education Research and Development. The S.S.E.R.D. is an organization which is elevated to promote astronomy among the general public and create awareness about the current inventions and innovations in this sector. On behalf of the S.S.E.R.D, Mr. Shivam Sharma, an accomplished aero-space engineer and expert aero modeler and designer, was the guest speaker for the session. Accompanying him were the organizers of the prestigious event, Mr. Shantanu, Mr. Neeraj Bhasim, Mr. Ajay Sharma, and Deepashish. The videos and documentaries displayed were provided by National Geographic. The workshop begun with the introduction of I.S.R.O.'s dream, Chandrayaan 2 which was followed by a video that captured every student's attention. Next, Mr. Sharma defined 'space' for the students. After that, he briefed the onlookers about the history of modern space exploration and about the Indian Space Research Organization. This was followed by the explanation of the term 'fleet' and the need for Chandrayaan 2 after which another video was shown to the audience. After this, he explained the working of Chandrayaan 2, which included the GSLV MKIII, the orbiter, the lander, the rover, and its trajectory. Next, the guest speaker told the audience why this mission was a special one which was followed by another video. The session culminated with a doubt session and a documentary on the Mangalyaan spacecraft.
