An Interactive Zoom meeting on COVID-19 and Promoting Youth Action was conducted by Mr. Samarth Pathak, United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime, on 23rd of April, 2020.

Students were shown a captivating Power Point Presentation on COVID-19 and its Areas of Concern, like Gender-Based Violence and Racial Discrimination. The Key Principle of 'Leaving no one behind', to fight COVID-19 in terms of social risks was also discussed upon.

Another point of interest was the linkages between various Sustainable Development Goals, and the importance of SDG 16: Peace, Justice, and Strong Institutions, which acts as a foundation for all other Goals.

Students were also recommended to work with the UNODC in terms of spreading awareness about COVID-19; that as students, what can WE do to help. It included Online Volunteering, Awareness and Ideas for Action.
