We are pleased to share with you that Online Classes are going to start from **Monday, 5th April, 2021 on Google Classroom.**

We request you to collaborate with us in this endeavor by making the following arrangements for your ward:

1. A laptop/ tab/Smartphone
2. A Wi-Fi connection

For the new session, we request you to kindly take note of the following points carefully:

A1 .Online Class Timings:

09:15am to 1:35pm

Total no. of classes each day: 6 (**mandatory to attend**)

Duration of a Class: 35 min.

Interval between the classes: 10 min

There will be PE classes in the evening.

A2. Online Class Time table:

Weakly time table will be shared with you shortly. Students are expected to join the class as per the time table. Link of classrooms will be shared by subject tutors. Once you receive the link you are expected to log in the classroom as per the directions given.

A2. Instructions for Online Classes:

- a. Students should have a proper study area well lit with a table and chair.
- b. Students are expected to be in their **School Uniform/House Uniform** (Nischay, Shakti, siddhant, Vishwas) during the class. Student will be allowed in the classroom only in the **School Uniform/House Uniform.**
- c. Camera of the device and Microphone should be in working condition.
- d. Students are expected to keep the microphone mute and video on while the class is going on
- e. All the doubts should be asked in chat and will be addressed by teacher before the class ends
- f. Assignment submission should be done on the date assigned and will be graded.
- g. Any student who is not attending the whole class (40 min) will be marked absent.

- h. If due to any technical issue (power or network failure) teacher is not able to take the class as per the schedule already given, that particular class will be rescheduled.

B. Attendance: 80% attendance is mandatory. The students are expected to log in the classrooms and attend the class of 40 min.

C. Safety and precautions: kindly ensure that your ward uses the web sites only in your presence or under your guidance. Your support in this endeavor will help us in smooth conduct of teaching – learning in this difficult time

D. Home Fun:

Students will be given home fun assignments to add to the teaching learning process. These assignments are given to inculcate thinking and communication skills in our students.

E. Stationery:

- II. **Grade 5-2** gel pens, 2 pencils, 1 eraser, 1 sharpener and 1 scale (6 inches) every day.

F. Assessment:

A.1 Instructions for Assessments:

- a. Students will be assessed for their skills during daily interactions and through different interactive activities.
- b. There will be a cycle of Monthly Recapitulation Assessment. It is a cycle of 5 subjects which takes place every month.
- c. The Assessments will be in form of a Quiz OR MCQ'S on Google Classroom.
- d. The assessment link will be shared with all the students on the day of Assessment.
- e. Once you click on the link, you will be able to access the Assessment.
- f. **Please note** - The time for attempting the Assessment will be from 9:15 am to 9:55 am.
After 9:55am, the assessment form will automatically expire and your answers will not be registered.
- g. The School does not encourage any Retest, however under medical conditions/Illness, retest will be allowed as per the following norms:
 1. Grade Tutor to be informed by the parents telephonically /email on the same day of the test.
 2. On joining back, the student is expected to get a medical Certificate/leave application
- h. We request all the parents **not to assist** their children whilst they attempt the questions


